



Chapter on Eligibility for Candidacy for the Executive Authority

Article 1/ Eligibility for Candidacy

Each candidate for membership of the Presidency Council and Presidency of the Government of National Unity must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Be a Libyan not holding another nationality unless he/she renounced or has received the relevant authorization;
- 2. Be aged 35 years or older on the day of candidacy for the Presidency Council, and 30 years or older for the presidency of the Government of National Unity.
- 3. Must not have been convicted in a case of financial corruption or violation of human rights or International Humanitarian Law.
- 4. Must not be a participant in the Libyan Political Dialogue Forum held under the auspices of the United Nations Support Mission in Libya (UNSMIL).

Article 2 / Binding Undertakings for Candidates

Each candidate shall be legally and morally bound to:

- 1. Present an undertaking to respect the Roadmap for the "Preparatory Phase for a Comprehensive Solution", for the electoral process and to respect its timeframe. This undertaking shall be made when each candidate presents her/his vision for implementing the Roadmap to the Libyan Political Dialogue Forum.
- 2. Submit a declaration of her/his own movable and immovable assets inside and outside Libya, as well as those of spouse and children. The candidate shall announce submission of the financial disclosure to the competent oversight authorities prior to assuming functions.
- 3. Holders of positions in the unified executive authority shall not run for general elections, which end the Preparatory Phase.
