<b>JOB DESCRIPTION:</b>	<p>Responsibilities: Under the overall guidance of the OiC, Chief Engineering Officer, the Electrical Technician will be responsible for the following duties:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Carries out all Electrical works assigned to him/her by his/her supervisor.</li> <li>• Assists in preparing the design, scope of works, specifications and bill of quantity for all horizontal and if required vertical works.</li> <li>• Applies Libyan as well as international Engineer standards and develops the project approach, project plan, cost estimate and time schedule with Engineering, Procurement and Finance.</li> <li>• Acts as site manager assistant and immediate supervisor for the working teams.</li> <li>• Has to carry out physical works if requested.</li> <li>• Reports regularly to the OiC, Chief Engineer and ensures the quality is delivered as specified in the technical documents and the result meets the expectations.</li> <li>• Has to provide quality assurance for the user. S/he monitors and approves field and laboratory tests and reports about aggregates, composition, compaction, density, plasticity and other subjects of quality requirements.</li> <li>• Carries out quantity survey and controls the expenditures as well as ensure that all costs stay within the budget.</li> </ul>
